- II. Terms (if necessary)

A brief overview of the purpose and description of the lab or programming assignment

III. Introduction

Document the assignment, what was asked and what you did. Include explanations of concepts and definitions.

IV. Design / Method/Work Done

Write a brief description of your code design. Sometimes this won't be very much. The intent is to tell me that you know what you did.

V. Results

This section will describe the output or results of the project. This may include screen shots, pictures, etc. Be sure to include text to explain the results

VI. Conclusion

Tell me what worked, what didn't work, what you learned, what you thought about the assignment (do you want more like it or less like this)

- VII. Code
 - a. Write a brief description of your code design. Sometimes this won't be very much.
 - b. Copy of the code/make files
 - c. Note that the code file must also be uploaded and submitted in Blackboard.

Important Reminders for a Lab Report

- 1) Spelling
- 2) Headings should stand out and each section should be separated by 1 line
- 3) Neatness counts -> use rulers when needed (especially when using tables and graphs), type if possible

Do not copy verbatim (word for word) from the lab handout or any other source. This is plagiarism and would result in a zero mark and possible further consequence
