I) Sampling

- A) Random Sampling-every potential sample size n has an equal probability to be selected.
 - 1) define pop
 - 2) indent every member
 - 3) Select Scores all equal probability of being chosen
- B) Stratified Sample-a sample drawn in such a way that it reflects exactly a known characteristic of the population.
- C) Biased Sampling- a method that systematically underestimates or overselects from certain groups within the population.
