Title - This does not have to be the title of your final paper but should make clear the area of mathematics education you are researching.	/ 5 points
Introduction - This section should include, but is not limited to, the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A brief discussion of why you are interested in the topic you have chosen.</li> <li>• A general/broad overview or description of past and current research findings conducted in your topic area.</li> <li>• A listing of at least 3 major themes/issues apparent in the research you have reviewed and will be including in your report.</li> </ul>	/ 25 points
Major Themes/Issues - This section should include, but is not limited to, the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Brief descriptions for each of the major themes/issues listed in your introduction. Descriptions should include how the teaching and learning of mathematics are affected by the major themes/issues.</li> <li>• A brief discussion of how the themes/issues are related.</li> </ul>	/ 30 points
Discussion - This section should include, but is not limited to, the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recommendations (implications) from the research for improving the teaching and learning of mathematics with respect to the themes/issues mentioned.</li> <li>• Recommendations for further research needed within the area of your topic.</li> <li>• A brief discussion of your ideas about what you have read and learned to this point.</li> </ul>	/ 25 points
References - A reference page in APA style. You should have a minimum of 5 research studies and 2 supplementary sources at this point. In text citations should also be in APA style.	/ 5 points
